### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

#### 1. Jurisdiction

The event will be held under the Motorcycle Racing Association (Ireland) Ltd Competition Rules and Standing Regulations including any Supplementary Regulations as have or may be issued for the event.

#### 2. Eligibility

The event is open to riders competing on solo motorcycles who are holding a current competition license issued by the MRA and MCUI (SC). A.C.U. or S.A.C.U. & Continental FMN's.

#### 5. Event : *Expert, Senior and Clubman Cross country* **Start time: 10.30**

**Duration:** 2 hours (+1 lap) **Sign on:** 8.00 -9.30am. **Scrutineering** 8.30 – 10am

#### 6. Official Entry Form **must be completed in every detail and accompanied by the Entry Fee.**

Entry fees will only be returned in the event of the meeting being cancelled. The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry or to return any entry already received

#### 7. Exhausts Sound Level FIM: - Exhaust Sound level test on all machines, The sound level must be not exceed 96 BA as per method of sound control requirements and regs. Machines will be tested after signing on. Machines that pass will be given a pass mark then submitted for Scrutineering.

#### 8. Riders Briefing - This will take place on the start line 15 minutes before the race. The Clerk of the course will give the briefing.

#### 9. Start of a Race

The event is a dead engine start. Riders will line up in their respective class and will be let off by the drop of a flag by a start marshal. **10.30 am Start Sharp.**

## 10. Course

One full lap measures 9 kilometres approx. Consisting of Open Mountain, quarry tracks, farm lanes and Forestry, marked with rope, stakes and flags. Flag or marker cutting may entail exclusion, any rider leaving the course must return to it at the point at which he left it, penalty exclusion, except where it is inadvertent and no advantage is gained

**11. Refuelling:** This is a NO Smoking Area = (10mph speed limit in this area) Engines must be switched off while refuelling, failure to comply will result in exclusion. NO Children U16 years allowed inside pits and work area. There will be a number of fire points within the pit area, fire extinguishers are at these points.

## 12. Scrutineering of Machines

Riders must present their machines, clothing and helmet in racing condition for checking. Scrutineering will take place in the paddock from 8.30 a.m.- 10.00 a.m. Crash helmets must bear the 2016 M.R.A. stamp. Each Rider must have a current competition license available for inspection when signing on, which has to be done prior to scrutineering. A day licence is available on the day. A rider must not race any machine that is not scrutineered. All machines to be placed in parc ferme after scrutineering. Helmets and long Sleeve shirts must be worn at all times when you are riding your machine. No working lights required for XC. Bikes must be pushed across paddock.

## 13. Finish of a race

The Flag will go out at approx the 2 hour mark for Experts, Seniors, Clubman.

## 14. Stopping a race

A race if stopped prematurely for reasons of force majeure, may be run at the discretion of the promoters with the permission of the stewards

**15.** Any rider refusing medical attention will not be allowed to race further on the day.

**16.** No dogs or any other animals will be permitted at this venue.

**17.** Please Take all Rubbish Home with you. Thank YOU

**18.** No pit bikes or scooters or bicycles will be permitted at this venue
